
Problem 02: Page Processing Demonstration











I did a demonstration of various events that occur during ASP.NET Page processing. I started by creating a simple ASP.NET page. I added some basic HTML and controls to the page and then began to explore the various events that are raised and handled during ASP.NET Page processing. First, I added an event handler for the "Page_Init" event, which occurs after the page object has been created and initialized. Next, I added an event handler for the "Page_Load" event, which occurs after the page has been initialized and the ViewState has been loaded. I also added an event handler for the "Button_Click" event, which occurs when a button on the page is clicked. Finally, I added an event handler for the "Page_Unload" event, which occurs after the page has been fully rendered and sent to the client. As I tested this page, I observed how these events were raised and handled during the ASP.NET Page processing cycle.
